



# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan

as of 20 January 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 17 January 2024 at around 4:45 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan. The fire was declared out at around 6:00 AM. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) MIMAROPA

# **II.** Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **16 families** or **47 persons** are affected in **Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **nine (9) families** or **24 persons** currently taking temporary at the **Barangay Hall** of **Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex B).

- b. Outside Evacuation Center There are seven (7) families or 23 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).
- c. Total Displaced Population There are 16 families or 47 persons displaced in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (see Annex D).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **nine (9) houses** were damaged; of which, **six (6)** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex E).

# V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱168,208.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱22,728.00 from DSWD and ₱145,480.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
