



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Pandacan, Manila City

as of 12 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 11 January 2024 at around 5:44 AM, a fire incident occurred at Dapo St., West Zamora, Brgy. 850 in Zone 93, Pandacan, Manila City that also affected the nearby barangays 849 and 852. The fire was declared out at around 8:26 AM.

A total of **413 families** or **1,387 persons** are affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Pandacan**, **Manila City** (see Annex A).
