

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in the Public Wet Market of City of San Fernando, La Union

I. Situation Overview

On 11 January 2024 at around 2:20 AM, a fire incident occurred at the Public Wet Market in Brgy. Ilocanos Sur, City of San Fernando, La Union that affected the livelihood of stall owners and vendors.

A total of **1,501 stall owners and vendors** are affected in the **City of San Fernando, La Union** (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱540,799.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱149,000.00** from **DSWD** and **₱391,799.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex B).
