

DSWD DROMIC Report #25 on the Mw 7.4 Earthquake Incident in Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur as of 31 May 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

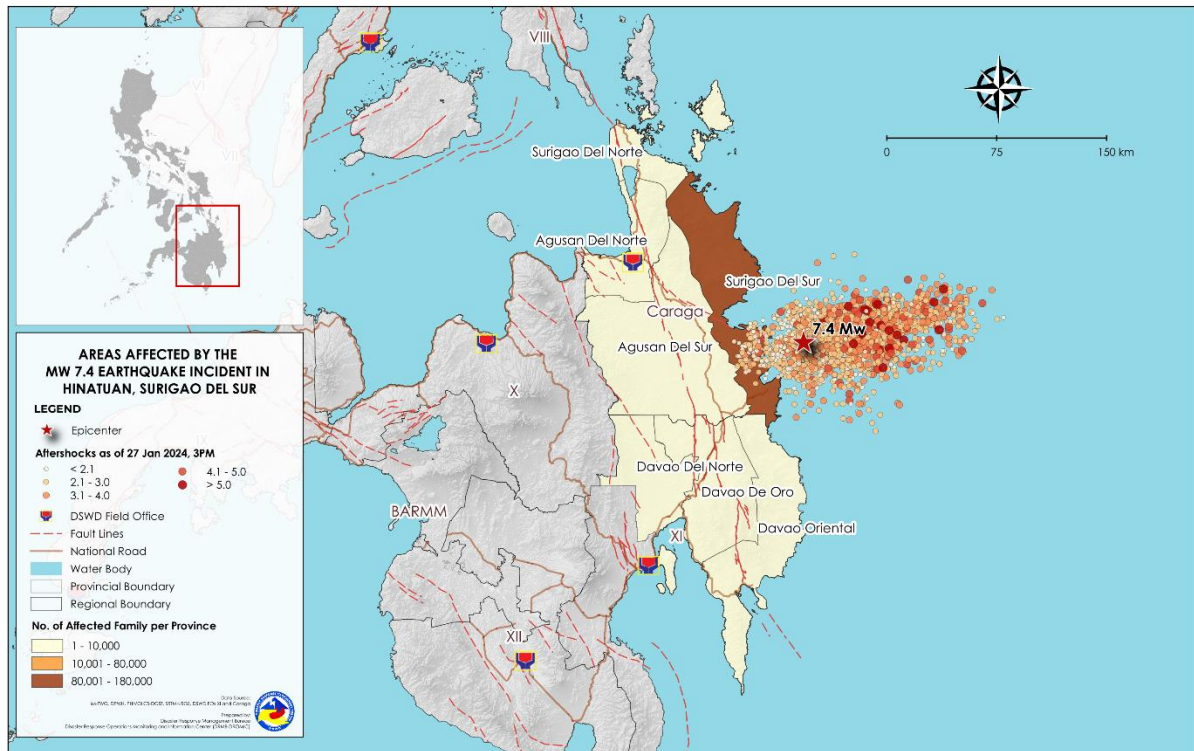
On 02 December 2023 at 10:37 PM, a 7.4-magnitude earthquake jolted the Municipality of Hinatuan, Surigao Del Sur (08.44°N, 126.59°E - 029 km N 74°E) with a tectonic origin and a depth of focus at 026 km. The earthquake was also felt in nearby municipalities.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **178,852 families** or **721,204 persons** are affected in **429 barangays** in **Regions XI and Caraga** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **55,268 families** or **207,453 persons** sought temporary shelter in **204 evacuation centers** in **Regions XI and Caraga** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **50,058 families** or **216,495 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **105,326 families** or **423,948 persons** were displaced in **Regions XI and Caraga** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **10,038 houses** were damaged; of which, **442** are **totally damaged** and **9,596** are **partially damaged** in **Regions XI and Caraga** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of DSWD Assistance Provided

A total of **₱184,484,575.56** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families, of which, **₱114,115,545.56** are **food and non-food items (FNIs)**, **₱4,654,000.00** are **financial assistance** through **Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS)**, and **₱65,715,030.00** through **Emergency Cash Transfer (ECT)** (see Table 1).

DSWD FO Caraga's Regional and Provincial QRTs are activated and deployed to their respective Areas of Responsibility (AORs) to monitor and provide the necessary assistance to the LGUs relative to the effects of the earthquake incident. DSWD FO Caraga lead by Regional Director Mari-Flor D. Libang maintained close coordination with the affected LGUs and other concerned offices for significant updates and any requests for relief augmentation. The QRT in Surigao del Sur specifically in the municipalities of Hinatuan and Tago were deployed in the evacuation centers to provide assistance to the LGUs.
