





DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Armed Conflict in Malaybalay City, Bukidnon

as of 10 January 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 December 2023 at around 3:00 AM, an armed conflict transpired in Malaybalay City, Bukidnon between the 4th Infantry Division (4ID) of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA).

Reports indicated series of encounters in the barangays of Can-ayan, Kibalabag, Kulaman, and Mapulo likewise, the LGU of Malaybalay City, assures the safety of the residents but the ongoing military operations affected their livelihood as they were advised to temporarily refrain from going back to their respective farms.

Local authorities and disaster management teams are actively engaged in the response operation to address the concerns of the affected populations and manage the incident caused by the conflict.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 680 families or 3400 persons are affected in four (4) barangays in Malaybalay City, Bukidnon (see Annex A).
