

# DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) as of 18 February 2025, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

On 07 December 2024, several barangays in the municipality of Dipolog City, Zamboanga del Norte experienced heavy rainfall and flooding due to ITCZ.

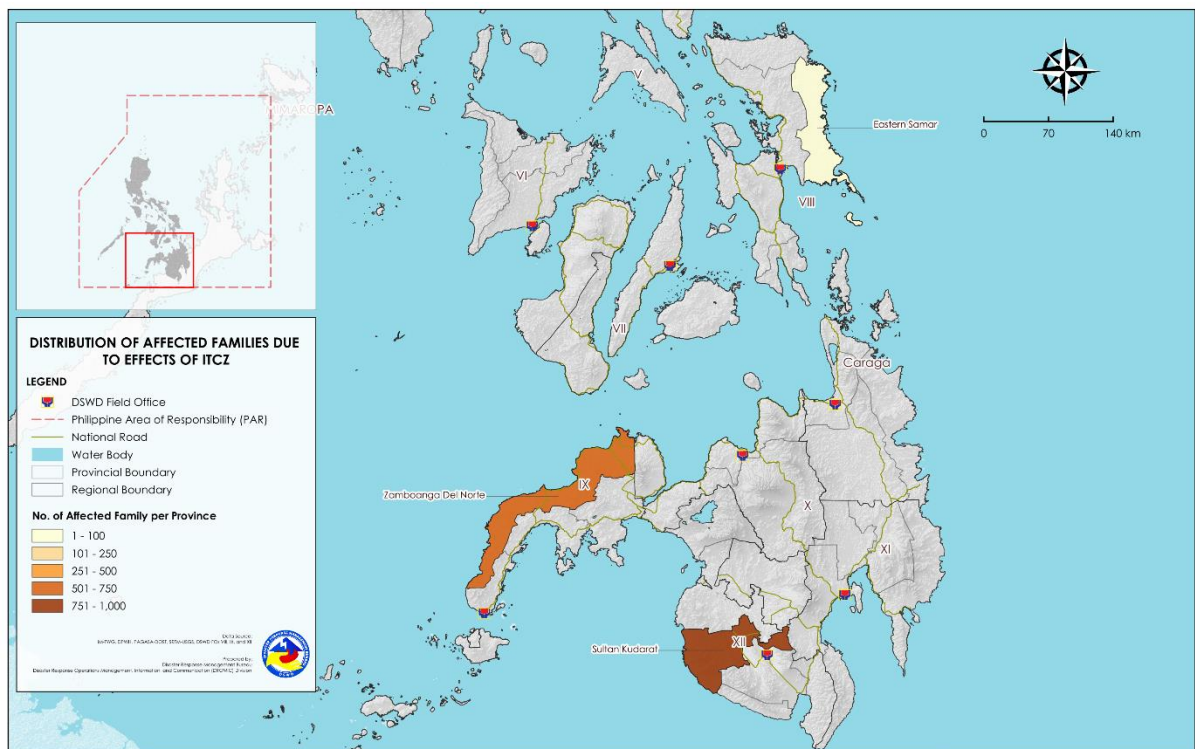
On 08 December 2024, the municipality of Salcedo, Eastern Samar experienced Tornado Incident due to ITCZ.

On 09 December 2024, the municipality of Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat also reported several flooding incidents brought by the effects of ITCZ.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,430 families** or **6,333 persons** are affected in **six (6) barangays** in **Regions VIII, IX and XII** (see Annex A).

### Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **659 families** or **3,294 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

One (1) house was partially damaged in Region VIII (see Annex C).

A total of **₱556,265.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
