



# **DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Effects of Shear Line**

as of 18 January 2024, 6PM

# I. Situation Overview

On 15 January 2024, the effects of Shear Line were experienced in several municipalities in the province of Agusan del Sur and Surigao del Sur.

On 16 January 2024, several municipalities in the Davao Region also reported the effects of Shear Line.

On 18 January 2024 at 4PM, cloudy skies with scattered rain showers and thunderstorms brought by the Shear Line may have caused possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in Mindanao.




Figure 1. Areas affected by LPA and Shear Line

# **II.** Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **95,065 families** or **392,296 persons** are affected in **245 barangays** in **Regions XI** and **Caraga** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **3,968 families** or **13,961 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **91 evacuation centers** in **Regions XI** and **Caraga** (see Annex B).





### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **5,987 families** or **22,970 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

### c. Total Displaced Population

There are 9,955 families or 36,931 persons displaced in Regions XI and Caraga (see Annex D).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **16 houses** were damaged; of which, **three (3)** are **totally damaged** and **13** are **partially damaged** in **Region XI** (see Annex E).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱9,449,664.00 worth of food items was provided by DSWD to the affected families; (see Table 1).
