

DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Effects of Trough of Low Pressure Area (LPA) as of 01 February 2024, 6PM

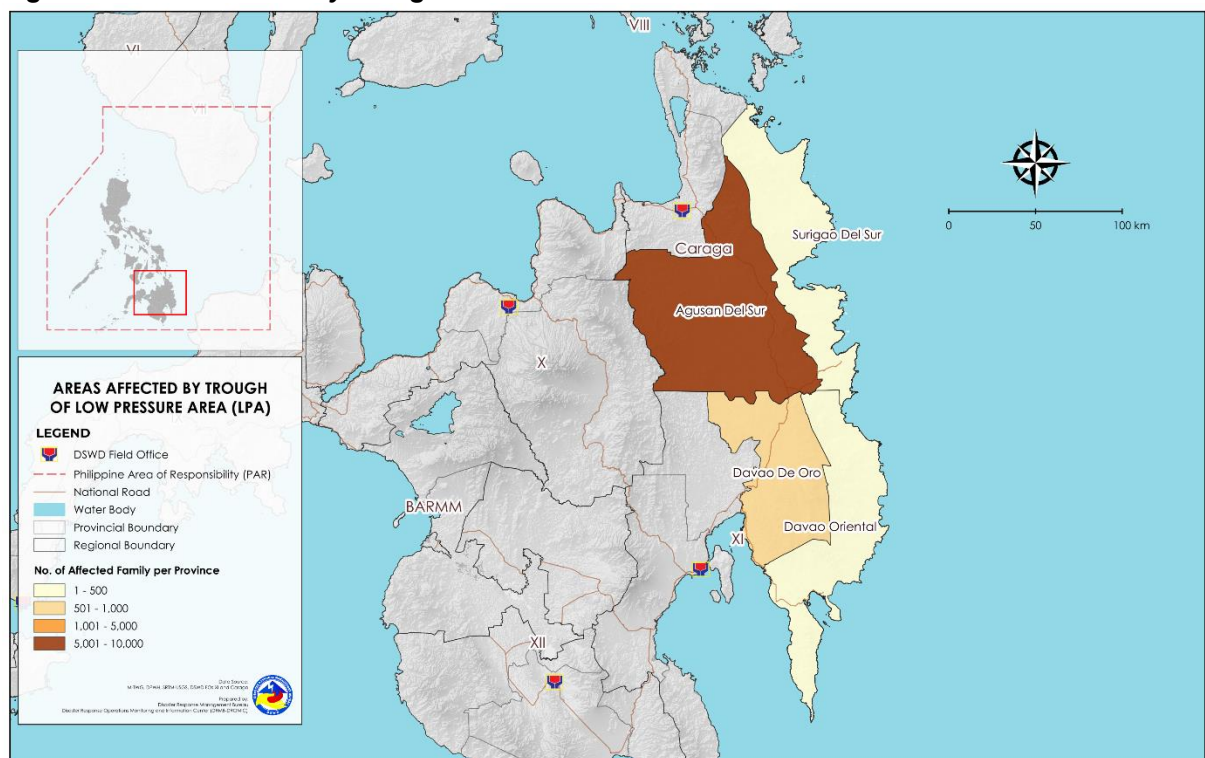
I. Situation Overview

On 29 January 2024, the Municipalities of Compostela, Monkayo, and New Bataan in Davao de Oro and the Municipalities of Bunawan and Rosario in Agusan del Sur experienced the effects of the trough of LPA.

Issued on 01 February 2024, at 4PM, Mindanao, Central Visayas, Negros Occidental, and Southern Visayas are experiencing cloudy skies with scattered to widespread rains and thunderstorms caused by the trough of LPA, which may bring possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to heavy to at times intense rain.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **27,841 families** or **103,757 persons** are affected in **171 barangays** in **Regions XI and Caraga** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **7,101 families** or **26,442 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **137 evacuation centers** in **Regions XI** and **Caraga** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **7,447 families** or **27,631 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **14,548 families** or **54,073 persons** displaced in **Regions XI** and **Caraga** (see Annex F).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **nine (9) houses** were damaged; of which, **three (3)** are **totally damaged** and **six (6)** is **partially damaged** in **Caraga** (see Annex G).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱ 2,017,554.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱647,214.00** from **DSWD**, and **₱1,370,340.00** from the **Local Government Units (LGUs)** (see Annex H).
