
DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City as of 10 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 January 2024 at around 11:33 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Kanipaan, Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City. The fire was declared out on 07 January at around 3:55 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **144 families** or **636 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **95 families** or **387 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Basak Community School** in **Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **49 families** or **249 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **144 families** or **636 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **104 houses** were damaged; of which, **93** are **totally damaged** and **11** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱730,496.75** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families, of which **₱55,496.75** from **DSWD** and **₱675,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).

06 January 2024	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DSWD FO VII through its DRMD alerted its Quick Response Team (QRT) and coordinated with the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) and the City Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office (CDRRMO) of the LGU of Cebu City for further information on the fire incident. • DSWD FO VII ensured the availability of FNIs for possible relief augmentation to the LGU of Cebu City.
