



# DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City

as of 10 January 2024, 6PM

# I. Situation Overview

On 06 January 2024 at around 11:33 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Kanipaan, Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City. The fire was declared out on 07 January at around 3:55 AM.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **144 families** or **636 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **95 families** or **387 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Basak Community School** in **Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City** (see Annex B).

- b. Outside Evacuation Center There are 49 families or 249 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).
- c. Total Displaced Population There are 144 families or 636 persons displaced in Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City (see Annex D).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **104 houses** were damaged; of which, **93** are **totally damaged** and **11** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Basak Pardo**, **Cebu City** (see Annex E).

# V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱730,496.75 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families, of which ₱55,496.75 from DSWD and ₱675,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
