



## DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Palatiw, Pasig City

as of 25 April 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 24 January 2024 at around 10:30 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Palatiw, Pasig City. The fire was declared out at around 12:06 PM.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **56 families** or **185 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Palatiw, Pasig City** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **48 families** or **124 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Bilog Palatiw Covered Court** in **Brgy. Palatiw, Pasig City** (see Annex B).

# b. Outside Evacuation Center A total of eight (8) families or 61 persons temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population A total of 56 families or 185 persons were displaced in Brgy. Palatiw, Pasig City (see Annex D).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **22 houses** are **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Palatiw, Pasig City** (see Annex E).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱117,804.40** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
