## **DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Titunod, Kolambugan, Lanao del Norte**

as of 12 January 2024, 6PM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On the evening of 07 January 2024 at around 9:50 PM, a fire incident transpired at Brgy. Titunod, Kolambugan, Lanao del Norte, causing damage to lives and properties. The Bureau of Fire Protection declared that the fire is control at around 12:49 AM the next day.

In response, local authorities and disaster management teams of Kolambugan, Lanao del Norte actively engaged in the response operation to address the displacement concerns of the affected populations and manage the incident caused by the incident.

### **II. Status of Affected Areas and Population**

A total of **37 families** or **139 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Titunod, Kolambugan, Lanao del Norte** (see Annex A).

### **III. Status of Displaced Population**

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **37 families** or **139 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Kolambugan Civic Center** in **Brgy. Titunod, Kolambugan, Lanao del Norte** (see Annex B).

### **IV. Damaged Houses**

A total of **37 houses** were damaged; of which, **33** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Titunod, Kolambugan, Lanao del Norte** (see Annex C).

### **V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱379,454.50** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱304,454.50** from **DSWD** and **₱70,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
