





DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Pandacan, Manila City

as of 18 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 11 January 2024 at around 5:44 AM, a fire incident occurred at Dapo St., West Zamora, Brgy. 850 in Zone 93, Pandacan, Manila City that also affected the nearby barangays 849 and 852. The fire was declared out at around 8:26 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 402 families or 1,527 persons are affected in three (3) barangays in Pandacan, Manila City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Affected Areas and Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **357 families** or **1,351 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **four (4) evacuation centers** in **Pandacan, Manila City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **45 families** or **176 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **402 families** or **1,527 persons** displaced in **Pandacan**, **Manila City** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **192 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Pandacan, Manila City** (see Annex E).

- 37,484 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱891.43 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
