

DSWD DROMIC Report #34 on the Effects of a Low Pressure Area (LPA) and Shear Line as of 05 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 November 2023, a landslide incident occurred in Brgy. Pong-on, Bontoc in the Province of Southern Leyte due to the effects of LPA and Shear Line.

On 17 November 2023, the effects of LPA and Shear Line were also reported in the Municipalities of Magarao, Camarines Sur and San Miguel, Catanduanes. On the same day, several barangays in Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental also experienced flooding due to the effects of Shear Line while the Municipality of Pres. Carlos P. Garcia in Bohol, and Catmon and Madrideojos in Cebu also reported the effects of the prevailing weather disturbances.

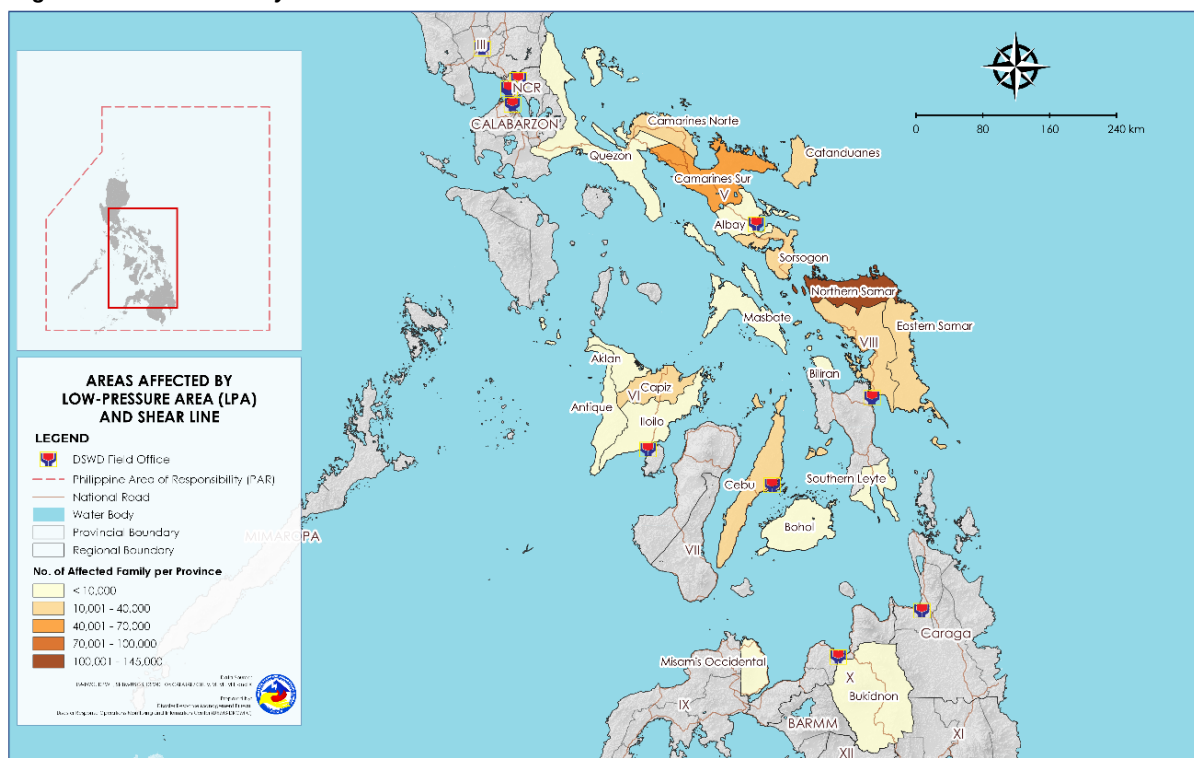
On 20 November 2023, several municipalities in the Provinces of Aklan and Capiz experienced flooding due to the effects of Shear Line.

On 21 November 2023, the Provinces of Camarines Norte, Masbate, and Sorsogon in the Bicol Region and the Provinces of Biliran, Eastern Samar, Northern Samar, Western Samar, and Southern Leyte in Eastern Visayas have reported the effects of Shear Line. On the same day, additional affected areas were reported in Western Visayas.

On 25 November 2023, several municipalities in the Province of Quezon in CALABARZON experienced flooding due to the effects of Shear Line.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **362,160 families** or **1,473,942 persons** are affected in **1,819 barangays** in **Regions CALABARZON, V, VI, VII, VIII, and X** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **4,766 families** or **19,969 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **62 evacuation centers** in **Regions CALABARZON and VIII** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **1,071 families** or **3,627 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **5,837 families** or **23,596 persons** displaced in **Regions CALABARZON and VIII** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **20,798 houses** were damaged; of which **677 houses** are **totally damaged** and **20,121** are **partially damaged** in **Regions V, VI, and VIII** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of DSWD Assistance Provided

A total of **₱296,971,462.27** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families; of which, **₱240,295,462.27** are **food and non-food items (FNIs)** and **₱56,676,000.00** are **financial assistance** through **Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS)** (see Table 1).
