## **DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** as of 25 January 2024, 6PM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 17 January 2024 at around 4:45 AM, a fire incident transpired in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan causing displacement to families and individuals.

### **II. Status of Affected Areas and Population**

A total of **16 families** or **47 persons** are affected in **Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex A).

### **III. Status of Displaced Population**

#### **a. Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **10 families** or **26 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Barangay Rural Health Unit of Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex B).

#### **b. Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **six (6) families** or **21 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### **c. Total Displaced Population**

There are **16 families** or **47 persons** displaced in **Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex D).

### **IV. Damaged Houses**

A total of **nine (9) houses** were damaged; of which, **six (6)** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex E).

### **V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱667,208.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱230,728.00** from **DSWD**, **₱349,480.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** and **₱87,000.00** from **Others Partners** (see Annex F).
