

DSWD DROMIC Report #8 on the Effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ)

as of 29 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 November 2024, several barangays in the municipality of Malita, Davao Occidental experienced flooding due to continuous heavy rainfall brought by the ITCZ. At around 7:00 PM, the municipality of Monkayo, Davao De Oro also experienced flooding and landslides due to heavy rains brought by the ITCZ.

On 25 November 2024, a flooding incident was experienced in Brgy. Calagdaan, Cantillan while a landslide incident in Brgy. Tambis, Barobo in Surigao del Sur.

On 29 November 2024, a flooding incident due to heavy rains brought by the ITCZ was also experienced in Brgy. Sta. Isabel, Sta. Filomena and Turno, Dipolog City. On the same day, a flooding incident was experienced in Oroquieta City, Misamis Occidental.

On 30 November 2024, at around 2:00 PM, a landslide incident due to heavy rains brought by ITCZ was experienced in Brgy. Minapasuk, Calatrava, Negros Occidental. Source: DOST PAGASA Weather Bulletin and DSWD Field Offices (FOs)

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,337 families** or **5,599 persons** are affected in **16 barangays** in **Regions VI, X, IX, XI** and **Caraga** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of 666 families or 2,313 persons sought temporary shelter in nine (9) evacuation centers in Regions X and XI (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **608 families** or **3,040 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population There are 608 families or 3.040 persons still displaced

There are **608 families or 3,040 persons** still displaced in **Regions IX** and **Caraga** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **10 houses** were damaged; of which, **one (1)** was **totally damaged** and **nine (9)** were **partially damaged** in **Regions VI, XI** and **Caraga** (see Annex E).



V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱369,067.83 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of ₱79,667.83 from DSWD and ₱289,400.00 from the Local Government Units (LGUs) (see Annex F).
