





DSWD DROMIC Report on the Lightning Incident in Brgy. Magdalo, Banate, Iloilo

25 January 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 8 May 2023, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated light rains caused by easterlies and localized thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in the rest of the country.

Reportedly, the victims were excavating charcoal when heavy rain forced them to seek shelter in a nearby nipa hut. Around 3:00 PM, as the rain subsided, lightning struck the hut, resulting to 12 casualties' composed of three (3) victims who were pronounced Dead on Arrival (DOA) while the remaining nine (9) were hospitalized and discharged the same day.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI, promptly provided intervention to support the immediate needs of affected families and individuals by means of financial assistance through the Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS).
