

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Sag-ang, La Castellana, Negros Occidental

25 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 17 January 2024 at around 11:00 AM, an armed conflict occurred at Brgy. Sag-ang, La Castellana, Negros Occidental resulting to displacement of 31 families' equivalent to 126 persons.

Later that day, displaced families have safely returned to their residences as the Philippine Army granted the clearance.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI together with the LGU of La Castellana, Negros Occidental, promptly provided intervention to support the immediate needs of affected families and individuals by means of relief assistance.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **31 families** or **126 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Sag-ang, La Castellana, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱174,517.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱164,517.00** from **DSWD** and **₱10,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex B).
