

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Shariff Saydona Mustapha, Maguindanao del Sur

22 January 2025, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

On 11 January 2024 at around 10:30 AM, an armed conflict transpired between the alleged members of the 105<sup>th</sup> Base Command and the combined force of 106<sup>th</sup> and 118<sup>th</sup> Base Command of the Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) at Sitio Patawili, Brgy. Ganta, Shariff Saydona Mustapha, Maguindanao del Sur. The conflict led to the displacement of numerous families and individuals within the affected community.

In response to the incident, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) through its Field Office in Region XII, provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected populace.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,169 families** or **5,845 persons** were affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Shariff Saydona Mustapha, Maguindanao del Sur** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **379 families** or **1,895 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Bakat Masijid Evacuation Center** in **Shariff Saydona Mustapha, Maguindanao del Sur** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center A total of 790 families or 3,950 persons temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

### c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **1,169 families** or **5,845 persons** were displaced in **Shariff Saydona Mustapha, Maguindanao del Sur** (see Annex D).

## IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱754,005.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).
