





# DSWD DROMIC Report on the Drowning Incident in Brgy. Managopaya, Banate, Iloilo City

11 January 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 08 May 2023 at around 02:18 PM, a drowning incident occurred at Brgy. Managopaya, Banate, Iloilo City which resulted in one (1) casualty. The Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) reported two drowning victims, with one pronounced dead.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI in coordination with the LGU of Banate, Iloilo City, promptly provide intervention to support the immediate needs of the affected individuals.

A total of **two (2) persons** were affected in **one (1) barangay** in **Brgy. Managapoya**, **Banate**, **Iloilo**. (see Annex A).
