# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Effects of Northeast Monsoon in Cagayan Valley

27 January 2025, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

On 30 November 2023, the effects of Northeast Monsoon were reported in the municipality of Baggao, Cagayan.

On 23 December 2023, several barangays in the municipalities of Ballesteros and Allacapan also in the province of Cagayan experienced flooding incidents due to the effects of Northeast Monsoon.

On 01 January 2023, Brgy. Nagbacalan in the municipality of Ramon, Isabela experienced flooding due to rains brought by the Northeast Monsoon.

Issued on 13 January 2023 at 4:00PM, cloudy skies with light rains brought by the Northeast Monsoon is still prevalent over mainland Cagayan, Isabela, Aurora, Quezon, Oriental Mindoro, Marinduque, Romblon, Bicol Region, and Western Visayas.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **656 families** or **2,364 persons** were affected in **20 barangays** in **Region II** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **48 families** or **187 persons** sought temporary shelter in **seven (7) evacuation centers** in **Cagayan** (see Annex B).

### b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **276 families** or **960 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

### c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **324 families** or **1,147 persons** were displaced in the province of **Cagayan** in **Region II** (see Annex D).

## IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱444,900.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).
