I. Situation Overview

On 12 January 2024, the coastal barangays in municipality of New Washington, Aklan experienced heavy rains, strong winds, and rough seas caused by the Northeast Monsoon that impacted on the livelihood of families, who are mostly fisherfolk, residing in the affected areas.
