

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 19-B, Davao City

I. Situation Overview

On 11 January 2024 at around 11:51 PM, a fire incident occurred at Block 5, Lot 14, Gold Street, Mineral Village, Bajada, Brgy. 19-B, Davao City, Davao del Sur. The fire was declared out at around 12:57 AM.

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **31 families** or **130 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Mineral Village Covered Court** in **Brgy. 19-B, Davao City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **13 houses** were damaged; of which, **10** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 19-B, Davao City** (see Annex C).
