



# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Banaba, San Mateo, Rizal

27 March 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 07 January 2024, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Banaba, San Mateo, Rizal. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) CALABARZON

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **83 families** or **392 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Banaba, San Mateo**, **Rizal** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **83 families** or **392 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Donya Pepeng Covered Court** in **Brgy. Banaba, San Mateo, Rizal** (see Annex B).

#### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **83 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Banaba, San Mateo, Rizal** (see Annex D).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱944,850.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱102,700.00 from DSWD and ₱842,150.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex E).
