There are **83 families** or **392 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Donya Pepeng Covered Court** in **Brgy. Banaba, San Mateo, Rizal** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **83 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Banaba, San Mateo, Rizal** (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱944,850.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱102,700.00** from **DSWD** and **₱842,150.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex E).
