

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City

31 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 January 2024 at around 11:33 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Kanipaan, Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City. The fire was declared out on 07 January at around 3:55 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **145 families** or **636 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **115 families** or **461 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Basak Community School** in **Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **30 families** or **175 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **145 families** or **636 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City** (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **92 houses** were damaged; of which, **83** are **totally damaged** and **nine (9)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City** (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱5,350,773.75** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families, of which **₱408,552.75** from **DSWD** and **₱4,942,221.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex G).
