
DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Quiot, Cebu City, Cebu

21 March 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 18 January 2024 at around 4:06 AM, a fire incident broke out in Sitio Kawayan, Brgy. Quiot, Cebu City, Cebu. The incident has led to displacement of families and individuals in the community wherein 17 houses were razed to the ground.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VII, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Cebu City, provided relief augmentation to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **34 families** or **132 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Quiot, Cebu City, Cebu** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **34 families** or **132 persons** sought temporary shelter in **Quiot Pardo Elementary School** in **Brgy. Quiot, Cebu City, Cebu** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **17 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Quiot, Cebu City, Cebu** (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱1,152,152.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱85,304.00** from **DSWD** and **₱1,066,848.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex E).

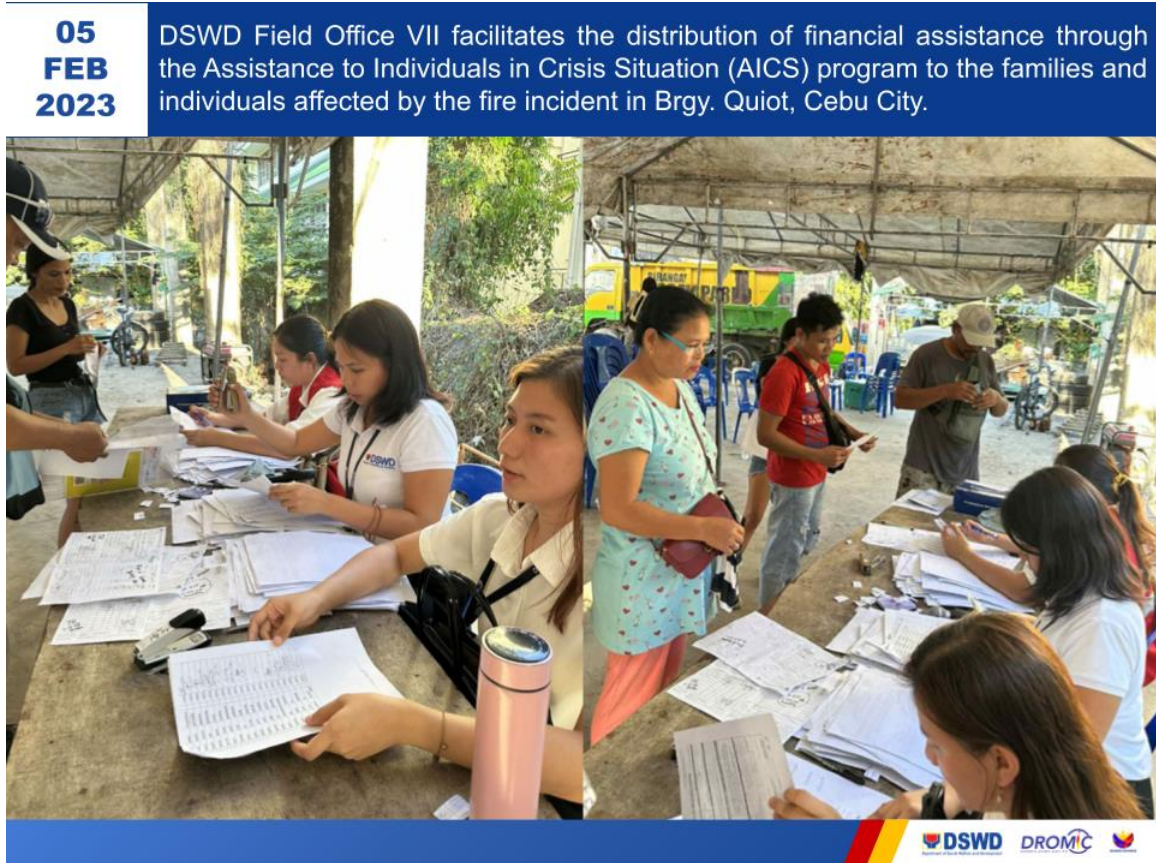
