

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan

12 May 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 17 January 2024 at around 4:45 AM, a fire incident transpired in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan causing displacement to families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **16 families** or **47 persons** were affected in **Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **ten (10) families** or **26 persons** sought temporary shelter at **Barangay Rural Health Unit** in **Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **six (6) families** or **21 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **16 families** or **47 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **nine (9) houses** were damaged; of which, **six (6)** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱667,208.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱230,728.00** from **DSWD**, **₱349,480.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** and **₱87,000.00** from **Others Partners** (see Annex F).
