





DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Lawaan III, City of Talisay, Cebu

29 February 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 17 January 2024 at around 1:01 PM, a fire broke out in Brgy. Lawaan III, City of Talisay, Cebu. The fire was reported at 1:01 PM, quickly escalating to a second alarm before being extinguished by 1:45 PM.

Consequently, the incident has led to displacement of families and individuals with a total of 21 houses engulfed by the fire. Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VII together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Talisay City, Cebu, provided relief and financial assistance to the support the identified needs of the affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 21 families or 93 persons were affected in Brgy. Lawaan III, City of Talisay, Cebu (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of five (5) families or 23 persons sought temporary shelter at the Brgy. Lawaan III Gym in the City of Talisay, Cebu (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **16 families** or **70 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of 21 families or 93 persons were displaced in Brgy. Lawaan III, City of Talisay, Cebu (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **21 houses** were damaged; of which, **13** are **totally damaged** and **8** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Lawaan III, City of Talisay, Cebu** (see Annex E).







V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱853,993.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; composed of ₱374,993.00 from DSWD and ₱479,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
