

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Baucawe, Lianga, Surigao del Sur

as of 15 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 February 2024 at around 7:45 AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Baugo, Brgy. Baucawe, Lianga, Surigao del Sur between the Philippine Army and members of the New People’s Army (NPA).

A total of **nine (9) families** or **39 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Baucawe, Lianga, Surigao del Sur** (see Annex A).

There are **nine (9) families** or **39 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided
