### I. Situation Overview

On 10 February 2024 at around 7:20 PM, an armed conflict transpired between two (2) unidentified armed groups in Brgy. Dados, Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte that resulted in the displacement of families and persons in the area.
