

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Palanggalan, Carmen, North Cotabato as of 17 February 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 15 February 2024 at around 6:00 AM, an armed conflict between the warring groups of Commander Teo Manalimbong of MILF 105<sup>th</sup> Base Command and Mohammed Saladuhin of NG-MILF occurred at Sitio Marmal, Barangay Palanggalan, Carmen, North Cotabato resulting to the displacement of families in the area.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,643 families** or **8,215 persons** are affected in **Barangay Palanggalan, Carmen, North Cotabato** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **1,643 families** or **8,215 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Barangay Palanggalan, Carmen, North Cotabato** (see Annex B).
