





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Palanggalan, Carmen, North Cotabato

as of 17 February 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 February 2024 at around 6:00 AM, an armed conflict between the warning groups of Commander Teo Manalimbong of MILF 105th Base Command and Mohammed Saladuhin of NG-MILF occurred at Sitio Marmal, Barangay Palanggalan, Carmen, North Cotabato resulting to the displacement of families in the area.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 1,643 families or 8,215 persons are affected in Barangay Palanggalan, Carmen, North Cotabato (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 1,643 families or 8,215 persons currently taking temporary shelter in three (3) evacuation centers in Barangay Palanggalan, Carmen, North Cotabato (see Annex B).
