





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Pinapugasan, City of Escalante, Negros Occidental

as of 23 February 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2024 at around 3:00 PM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Pinapugasan, City of Escalante, Negros Occidental between the troops of the Philippine Army and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA).
