

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. San Fernando, Laur, Nueva Ecija

as of 15 February 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 08 October 2023 at around 5:30 PM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. San Fernando, Laur, Nueva Ecija between troops of the 84<sup>th</sup> Infantry (Victorious) Battalion of the Philippine Army (PA) and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA).

A total of **121 families** or **605 persons** are affected in **Brgy. San Fernando, Laur, Nueva Ecija** (see Annex A).

#### Outside Evacuation Center

There are **121 families** or **605 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱460,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
