





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. San Fernando, Laur, Nueva Ecija

as of 15 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 08 October 2023 at around 5:30 PM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. San Fernando, Laur, Nueva Ecija between troops of the 84th Infantry (Victorious) Battalion of the Philippine Army (PA) and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA).

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 121 families or 605 persons are affected in Brgy. San Fernando, Laur, Nueva Ecija (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **121 families** or **605 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P460,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
