I. Situation Overview

On 16 February 2024, armed clashes arised in Sitio Marmal, Brgy. Palanggahan, Carmen, North Cotabato between 105th BC, MILF and NG-MILF due to land conflict. *Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) XII*

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,643 families** or **8,215 persons** are affected in **Carmen, North Cotabato** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **1,643 families** or **8,215 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Carmen, North Cotabato** (see Annex B).
