

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Carmen, North Cotabato

as of 18 February 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 16 February 2024, armed clashes arised in Sitio Marmal, Brgy. Palanggahan, Carmen, North Cotabato between 105<sup>th</sup> BC, MILF and NG-MILF due to land conflict.

A total of **1,643 families** or **8,215 persons** are affected in **Carmen, North Cotabato** (see Annex A).

There are **1,643 families** or **8,215 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Carmen, North Cotabato** (see Annex B).
