### I. Situation Overview

On 05 May 2023 at around 2:45 PM, an armed conflict between the Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) groups 105<sup>th</sup> and 106<sup>th</sup> Base Command transpired at the boundaries of Brgy. Paldong, Sultan sa Barongis, Maguindanao del Sur, Sitio Panabungan, and Brgy. Tinumigues, Lambayong Sultan Kudarat.
