

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat

as of 07 May 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 05 May 2023 at around 2:45 PM, an armed conflict between the Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) groups 105th and 106th Base Command transpired at the boundaries of Brgy. Paldong, Sultan sa Barongis, Maguindanao del Sur, Sitio Panabungan, and Brgy. Tinumigues, Lambayong Sultan Kudarat.

A total of **799 families** or **3,995 persons** are affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat** (see Table 1).
