

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Big Wave Incident in Brgy. Manicahan, Zamboanga City as of 13 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 11 February 2024 at around 7:00 PM, incidents of strong winds and big waves caused by the Northeast Monsoon affected the coastal areas at Sitio Aplaya in Brgy. Manicahan, Zamboanga City.

A total of **69 families** or **183 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Manicahan, Zamboanga City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **69 families** or **183 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **25 houses** were damaged; of which, **four (4)** are **totally damaged** and **21** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Manicahan, Zamboanga City** (see Annex C).
