





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Northeast Monsoon in Bicol Region

as of 08 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 13 January 2024 at 4AM, partly cloudy skies with light rains caused by the Northeast Monsoon were experienced in Bicol Region.

On 16 January 2024, moderate to rough seas and strong winds were experienced in the Eastern Seaboards of Southern Luzon which eventually had an impact on the livelihood of affected families, who are mostly fisher folks and farmers.
