



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Trough of Low Pressure Area (LPA)

as of 30 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 29 January 2024, the municipalities of Compostela, Monkayo, and New Bataan in Davao de Oro and the municipalities of Bunawan and Rosario in Agusan del Sur experienced the effects of the trough of the LPA.

Issued on 30 January 2024 at 4:00PM, the Northeast Monsoon continuously affects Luzon and Visayas while the Trough of a Low Pressure Area (LPA) continuously affects Mindanao.




Figure 1. Areas affected by Trough of LPA

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,722 families** or **6,893 persons** are affected in **21 barangays** in **Regions XI** and **Caraga** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **163 families** or **505 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **13** evacuation centers in Regions XI and Caraga (see Annex B).





b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **nine (9) families** or **33 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **172 families** or **538 persons** displaced in **Regions XI** and **Caraga** (see Annex D).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱1.27 billion Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱10 million available at DSWD FOs XI and Caraga
- ₱58.94 million available in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the effects of the Trough of LPA through inter-FO augmentation.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 308,738 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 282,738 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 26,000 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 149,224 FFPs available at DSWD FOs XI and Caraga.
- 1,089,330 FFPs in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the effects of the Trough of LPA through inter-FO augmentation.
- ₱1.59 billion worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO warehouses.
