





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 184, Pasay City

as of 20 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 February 2024 at around 1:09 PM, a fire incident occurred at Azalea and Gardenia St., Transmitter Area, Brgy. 184, Pasay City. The fire was declared out at around 2:18 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **35 families** or **142 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 184, Pasay City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **35 families** or **142 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy**. **184 Covered Court** in **Pasay City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 15 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. 184, Pasay City (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P165,021.15** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).
