





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 30, Cagayan de Oro City

as of 14 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 08 February 2024 at around 5:56 PM, a fire incident occurred at Ramon Chavez St., Brgy. 30, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 8:02 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **30 families** or **61 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 30, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **eight (8) families** or **(8) persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. 30 Hall** in **Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **22 families** or **53 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 30 families or 61 persons displaced in Brgy. 30, Cagayan de Oro City (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 10 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. 30, Cagayan de Oro City (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱99,690.00 worth of assistance was provided by the Local Government Unit (LGU) the affected families (see Annex G).
