## **DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 30, Cagayan de Oro City** as of 14 February 2024, 6PM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 08 February 2024 at around 5:56 PM, a fire incident occurred at Ramon Chavez St., Brgy. 30, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 8:02 PM.

### **II. Status of Affected Areas and Population**

A total of **30 families** or **61 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 30, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex A).

### **III. Status of Displaced Population**

#### **a. Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **eight (8) families** or **(8) persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. 30 Hall** in **Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex B).

#### **b. Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **22 families** or **53 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

#### **c. Total Displaced Population**

There are **30 families** or **61 persons** displaced in **Brgy. 30, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex E).

### **IV. Damaged Houses**

A total of **10 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 30, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex F).

### **V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱99,690.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** the affected families (see Annex G).
