I. Situation Overview

On 15 February 2023 at around 11:26 AM, a fire incident occurred at Alonzo cor. Fugoso St., Brgy. 330, Sta. Cruz, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 12:41 PM.

A total of 40 families or 135 persons are affected in Brgy. 330, Sta. Cruz, Manila City (see Annex A).

A total of 30 houses were damaged; of which, 28 are totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in in Brgy. 330, Sta. Cruz, Manila City (see Annex B).
