I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2024 at around 1:26 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 52, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 2:44 PM.

- 84,572 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 50,538 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 34,034 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 36,655 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR
- ₱584.56 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
