





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 54, Pasay City

as of 20 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 February 2024 at around 6:10 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 54, Pasay City. The fire was declared out at around 7:43 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **50 families** or **195 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 54**, **Pasay City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **50 families** or **195 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in a covered court in **Brgy. 54**, **Pasay City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 10 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. 54, Pasay City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P235,744.50** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
