

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 96, Pasay City as of 15 February 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 09 February 2024 at around 2:27 PM, a fire incident occurred at Tayco Compund, Brgy. 96, Pasay City. The fire was declared out at around 4:47 PM.

A total of **70 families** or **220 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 96, Pasay City** (see Annex A).

### III. Damaged Houses

A total of **38 houses** were damaged; of which, **25** are **totally damaged** and **13** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 96, Pasay City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱376,864.60** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
